Your application to study medicine at UNSW requires several steps. Make sure you review our Application Process as well as the key dates below to ensure you complete all the requirements.

Due to the current situation with COVID-19 and related travel restrictions, UNSW Medicine has made the decision to conduct all interviews for entry into the BMed/MD program for Term 1 2022 online. This means that applicants will not be required to come to one of our campuses for a face-to-face interview, but instead join the interview online from home. 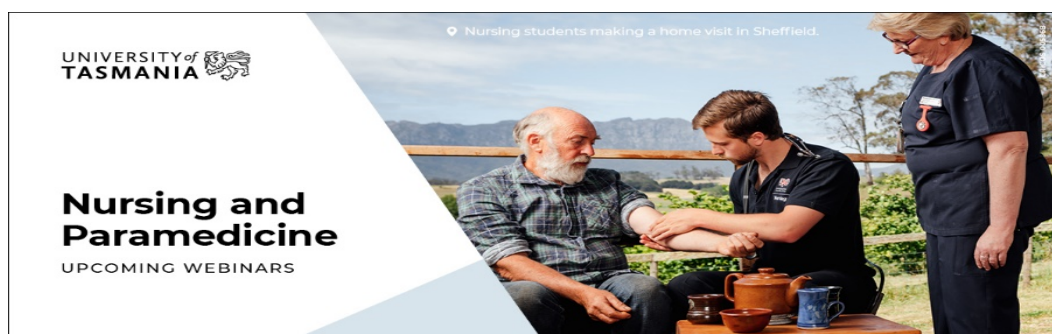
