

Year 10 Recognition Evening 2025

The Year 10 Recognition Evening is an event organised by staff and connected to our key school goal of recognising achievement. Since its inception in 2011, strict criteria are applied when inviting students to this event to ensure a successful and safe evening.

Students who do not fulfil **all criteria** will not, unless there are significant extenuating circumstances (Principal's discretion), be invited to attend.

These criteria include behaviour, academic and attendance aspects.

Students will not be invited if they have, in 2025:

- failed to achieve the qualification for a NESA Record of School Achievement (ROSA). This means that students must receive at least an E grade in ALL core courses and have not been N-determined.
- failed to have received a minimum of an E grade on both elective courses.
- outstanding N-Warnings.
- more than 5 Parent Advice Letters (PALs).
- achieved an overall attendance percentage of less than 85% both across the year and in Term 4.
- incomplete after school detentions.
- unpaid contributions other than the voluntary school contribution and P & C contributions (subject to Principal discretion following prior communication from home on the matter).
- been suspended more than once.
- been suspended once and have accrued more than 5 after school detentions (any type).
- been suspended once for a matter involving drugs, alcohol, vaping, prohibited weapons or criminal behaviour connected with the school.
- failed to participate in Mock Interviews.

Students will be expected to attend school on the day of the Recognition Evening until midday, without exception.

These criteria started in 2011 and have been consistently and rigidly applied since. The criteria are regularly communicated to students throughout the year **and are not negotiable**. We will undertake to work with all students to attempt to ensure that every student meets our expectations. However, for students who, through their own actions, become ineligible to attend, we will formally advise them when the invitation list is finalised.
