FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL 2025



THURSDAY 6TH FEBRUARY 2025

- Due to recent changes, ALL students from Year 7-12 will return to school on Thursday 6th
 Feb.
- Students should arrive to school in their Cronulla High School **sports uniform** (including CHS cap) as this is a Thursday (sport day).
- Year 7 students should go straight to the HALL for a Year Meeting.
- Students should bring an exercise book and their pencil case, as well as recess and lunch. They will get their timetables on this day, and are not expected to bring all of their books.

Year 7 Camp Phone Policy

Students are encouraged to leave their devices at home to avoid the temptation.



Students are expected to turn their phone off and put it in their bag while at school. This includes school activities such as camps, school sport and excursions.



SEEN OR HEARD

Students are expected to turn their phone off and put it in their bag while at school. If seen or heard this is a breach of the policy.

The mobile phone policy applies during breaks as well as during class. Students are encouraged to connect with each other and engage in physical activities during breaks. Students are aware of the school rules and will be required to comply with them. Consequences will apply if students choose not to follow the mobile phone policy.

PROCEDURE FOR MISUSE OF MOBILE PHONES ON SCHOOL GROUNDS

DISCIPLINARY ACTION

Students are aware of the school rules and will be required to comply with them. As with all school rules, non-compliance will result in appropriate action being taken. Breaches will accumulate over a semester and will reset at the commencement of each new semester.

The following action will be taken if a mobile phone or headphones are seen or heard:

FIRST OFFENCE

- · Student will have their device confiscated immediately
- Device can be collected from the front office by the student at the end of the school day
- An Afternoon Detention will be issued
- Parents will be notified

SECOND OFFENCE

- · Student will have their device confiscated immediately
- Device can be collected from the front office by the student at the end of the school day
- An Afternoon Detention will be issued
- A Formal Caution to Suspend will be issued
- Parents will be contacted to discuss the repeated non-compliance

THIRD OFFENCE

- Student will have their device confiscated immediately
- Device can be collected by a parent only
- Student will be Suspended from school
- School, Student and a parent will meet face-to-face to discuss non-compliance

FURTHER OFFENCES

- Students who continue to breach the Mobile Phone policy after being suspended from school will have further consequences impose.
- If a student has their phone confiscated for breaching this policy, they must comply immediately. Failure to do so will result in additional disciplinary action.
