SWIMMING SKILLS ASSESSMENT

On **Tuesday 31 January 2023**, all Year 7 students will be leaving Cronulla High School at various times throughout the day to complete a Swimming Skills Assessment at **Swimmerz Academy Pool** (Wurrook Circuit, Caringbah).

The object of the assessment is to identify the swimming ability of each student which is important for events such as the school swimming carnival, school camp and excursions near the water. Students who are identified as a weak or non-swimmer (by a qualified instructor) will be required to participate in the Swim Fun Safety (SFS) program during Thursday SUMMER SPORT 1.

Equipment Required - Students are required to bring a towel, swimming costume, hat, swimming goggles and swimming cap (optional) and wear sports uniform. It is recommended that students change into their costumes at school to ensure that they are ready to participate.
