Applications

Undergraduate applications are streaming in steadily this year, with approximately 37,000 people having so far applied for undergraduate study in 2023. As it is the beginning of August, I am happy to report that all Year 12 students across the country can now apply.

	<p>All undergraduate courses are now listed on the UAC website and available for students to preference in their application. If your students can't find what they are looking for, please have them contact our Customer Service team for assistance.</p> <p>Schools Recommendation Scheme</p> <p>To date, UAC has received just over 11,000 SRS applications from across the country. This is one way students can receive an early offer based on Year 11 results and their school's recommendation.</p> <p>Before students can apply for SRS they must submit their UAC application.</p> <p>Three institutions have additional SRS criteria, and I would encourage students to check those details on the UAC website.</p> <p>Here are the SRS key dates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SRS applications close: 19 September 2022 • SRS school ratings due: 3 October 2022 • Close of preferences for an SRS offer: 3 November 2022 • First SRS offers: 11 November 2022

Reminder Next Deadline Soon - UNE and UON Joint Medical Program

To apply to the Joint Medical Program in 2023, you must complete the following three steps.

How to apply Step 1 – Should be done earlier by 17 May 2022.

Register with the University Clinical Aptitude Test (UCAT ANZ) office and attend a UCAT ANZ session at a nominated test site. Fees apply. Registration closes 17 May 2022. UCAT ANZ testing begins 1 July and concludes 12 August 2022. All enquiries concerning UCAT ANZ should be directed to the UCAT ANZ office.

Final bookings will be accepted until Monday 31 May at 11:59pm AEST and will incur the late fee of AUD \$85.

Step 2: Apply online to the Joint Medical Program - Applications close on 30 September 2022. Applications will open in August. You will have the opportunity to review your application after it has been submitted. For details and instructions on how to apply, please download the online application instructions.

Late applications will not be accepted under any circumstances.

Step 3: Apply through UAC by 30 September 2022


Submit your early bird application through the Universities Admission Centre (UAC) by 30 September 2022. Late applications may be accepted by UAC, but late fees apply.


You must include Joint Medical Program at the University of Newcastle/University of New England among your preferences. You can't change your preferences to add this program after 1 December 2022.

The Joint Medical Program is included in the Educational Access Scheme. Through the Educational Access Scheme (EAS) you can get up to four additional adjustment points if you have experienced educational or other disadvantage. For more information about the EAS see here.

No need to Apply for Smart and Skilled Fee-Free Scholarships

You do not need to apply.

If you do not meet the Fee-Free Scholarship eligibility criteria (see above), we will ask if there are other circumstances where you may be eligible for a Fee-Free Scholarship.

You will need to advise us if you believe you are eligible under the Domestic and Violence Fee-Free Scholarship criteria.

The Fee-Free scholarship covers the student course fee you would normally pay.

The NSW Government's new Smart and Skilled Fee-Free Scholarships mean that students can get the skills they need to get the job they want and their course fees will be covered.

Young people (aged 15-30) who meet the Smart and Skilled Fee-Free Scholarship criteria are eligible for a government subsidy which covers their Smart and Skilled course fee.




Eligible students can receive a single Fee Free Scholarship in a financial year, and two Fee-Free Scholarships across 4 financial years.

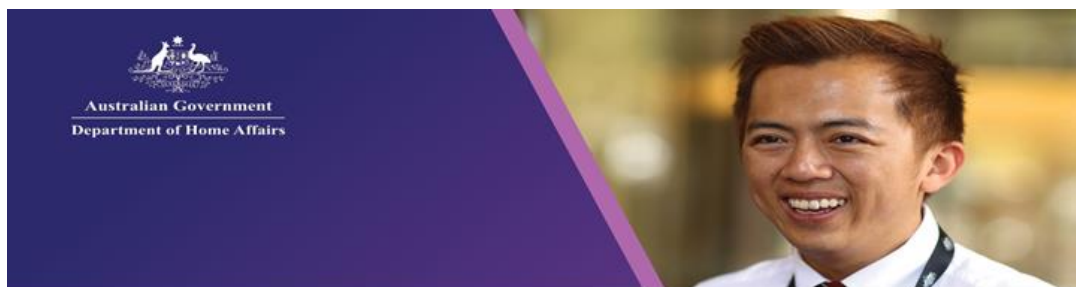
